

GIFT IDEAS FOR SENIORS



- A "Coupon" redeemable for you to run errands for them a few times a month or spend time with them.
- A Book of stamps/ pre-addressed mailing labels to frequently mailed addresses/ preprinted notecards
- Tickets for 2 or a season pass to the theatre, a play, a movie (including matinees), a museum (including transportation)
- Arrangements to weekly religious/community activities
- Pre-paid cab or bus "tickets" for rides when they want them
- Help with a special project (clean out the attic? organize the closets?)
- Offer to arrange family photos into an album
- A large print magazine/newspaper subscription, large print books, large print playing cards (auto. Shuffler) or books on tape, a large TV remote, large print calendars, large button telephone, magnifiers (such as thermostat magnifier or magnifying sheets for reading); talking or large print watch/thermometer, calculator, etc...
- Netflix subscription
- Install devices or home modifications to help prevent falls or accidents such as hand rails, non-slip stair pads, and automatic light sensors
- Gift certificates to grocery stores, restaurants, the pharmacy, manicurist or hair salon
- Gift certificate for monthly house cleaning
- Offer to rake leaves, shovel snow, or mow the lawn on regular basis
- DVD Player and/or favorite old movies/ shows on DVD)

- Prepay their utility bill (electric, cable, oil, telephone) or purchase gift certificate for winter's oil
- A gas card or prepaid phone calling card
- Calendar with family birthdays marked, stamped and addressed cards
- Cook extra meals and place in individual freezable containers or gift certificate for delivery
- Write a letter telling them how you feel about them and memories you have shared with them
- A month's enrollment in an Adult Day Program
- A monthly lunch date
- Offer yourself as a willing, cheerful helper for the day to do chores (change light bulbs, put batteries into smoke detectors, etc.)

- Install devices to prevent crime or vandalism (i.e.: deadbolts, door viewer, alarm system, etc.)
